How to Register Dogs when Social Distancing

A. Remote Registration

To cease human contact, consider opting for residents to swab their dogs themselves via video chat or at a viewable point (i.e. FaceTime, Skype, Facebook Messenger Video Call, Portal or through a window/glass door).

HOW TO:

1. Management will pre-register resident information into DNA World Pet Registry
2. Management should establish an isolated pick-up location - *resident's door/mailbox/misc.*
3. Resident should follow the kit and swab their dog in the comfort of their apartment and video call the community during process or at a viewable place outside leasing office - *please note to residents that any sample tampering will be discovered and fined*
4. Resident will then place kit in mailbox to return to PooPrints

B. Door-to-door Registration

To reduce unnecessary human contact, management staff can simply schedule appointment times with residents to have them swab their dog at their apartment while in front of staff.

HOW TO:

1. Management will pre-register resident information into DNA World Pet Registry
2. Management will set appointment times with residents - *we suggest going building by building*
3. Management would bring swab to resident, resident swabs their dog at their apartment with staff
4. Management will then place kit in mailbox to return to PooPrints

C. Maintenance Registration

To also reduce human contact but utilize maintenance staff in the sense of a "work order". This can allow management staff to stay onsite and assist in other matters while also registering dogs.

HOW TO:

1. Management will pre-register resident information into DNA World Pet Registry
2. Maintenance will bring swab to resident, resident swabs their dog
3. Maintenance will then place swab in mailbox to return to PooPrints
